Dear Opens Doors Donor,

As a donor who gives generously of your resources, it is our pleasure to share with you the 2021 MBA Opens Doors Foundation Annual Report.

Over the past year, as the pandemic lingered on, your support never wavered. In fact, it grew; and the strength of your commitment meant that thousands of families with critically ill or injured children, still facing economic hardship, had one less thing to worry about – the sanctity of their home.

In 2021, your donations allowed us to increase our support and to create our Pandemic Relief Program, which provided qualifying families with an extra month of housing assistance. It also allowed us to help more families in the month of September 2021, than in the first six years of the Foundation combined.

Despite the pandemic, the Opens Doors Foundation rallied to provide a record-breaking 2,734 grants to more than 2,100 families in FY 2021 - a 53% increase over the number of grants provided in FY2020. We disbursed more than \$4.2M in mortgage and rental payment assistance – twice as much as we disbursed in FY 2020. We also added the Children's Hospital at St. Francis in Tulsa to our network, bringing the total number of children's hospitals we partner with to 13 in eight states and the District of Columbia.

The enclosed annual report tells the stories of some of our Opens Doors families through the years and details the impact the pandemic has had on families with children in treatment. The report also includes a "retrospective" on our 10-year history and it includes the voices of our current board of directors whose passion and commitment feeds the engine of our organization.

None of the work and achievements of the Foundation would have been possible without you. With your help, the Opens Doors Foundation accomplished a great deal in 2021, despite the pandemic, and is making steady progress in our mission of helping families with critically ill or injured children stay in their homes.

As we ready for the coming holiday season, we are ever grateful for your support and hope that you will continue to work with us to help families with critically ill or injured children across America stay in their homes.
